What is Cohousing?

Cohousing is about building communities, not just housing, enabling the deeper connection at the core of our human need for belonging, providing social support between neighbours, and improving environmental sustainability.

Cohousing projects are designed, developed and organised by their residents, putting control and choice back into the people's hands, instead of large-scale developers'. Shared facilities and activities, including a common house, gardens, tools, and meals, mean that each resident enjoys a lifestyle, opportunities to learn and grow, and resources that they might not be able to obtain on their own, while maintaining their own private space and personal lives - and having more fun!

Cohousing is inclusive, welcoming individuals, couples and families of all ages, interests and occupations who are willing to participate and collaborate!

Cohousing Banyule was established in 2013, building on the vision of Transition Banyule (a part of Transition Network) to create resilient, vibrant communities and take action against climate change.
